

You'll be transiting through the high pressure center over the 24hrs where winds will remain relatively low. Winds will switch from being northerly before coming northerly as you get on the western side of the high. Winds will increase a bit as the pressure graident tightens with an approaching low, well southeast of your location. Seas out of the southwest will switch to northly and increase.
