A HIGH NORTH OF THE FALKAN ISLANDS AT 1027MB ADVECTS MOISTURE TOWARDS THE ARGENTINIAN COAST AND AS THIS FEATURE TRACKS FURTHER INTO THE ATLANTIC, A RELATIVELY WEAK MESOSCALE LOW IS EXPECTED TO DEVELOP OVER THE SOUTHERN TIP OF ARGENTINA. THIS LOW IS EXPECTED TO DRAW MOISTURE AWAY FROM THE PENINSULA AND PROVIDE CLEARING SKIES IN ITS WAKE WEDNESDAY. THURSDAY ANOTHER MESOSCALE LOW DEVELOPS FOLLOWING THE TRACK OF THE PREVIOUS LOW, INCREASING WINDS. A QUASI-STATIONARY LOW IN THE SOUTHERN OCEAN BEGINS TO MOVES TOWARDS DRAKE PASSAGE THURSDAY AFTERNOON. LIGHT MIXED PRECIPITATION AND PATCHY FOG IS EXPECTED IMPACT THE ANTARCTIC PENINSULA OVER THE NEXT 48 HOURS. WAVE HEIGHTS ARE EXPECTED TO BE RELATIVELY WEAK DUE

TO THE LOW'S DEFLECTION OF WINDS.
