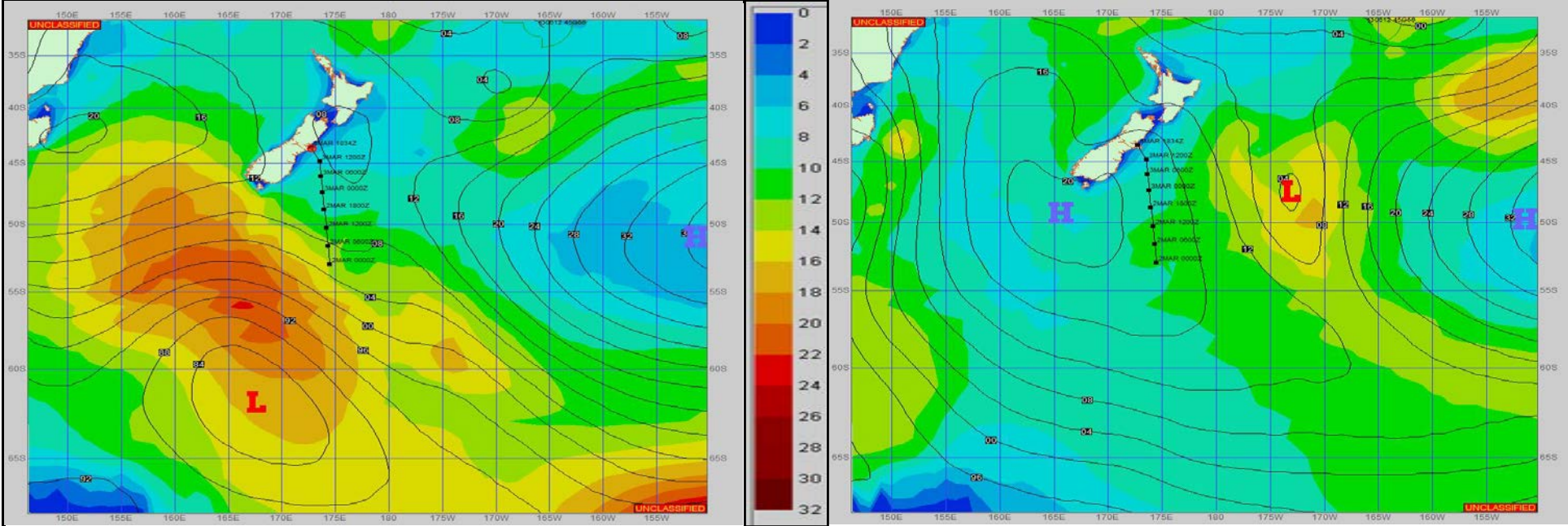

The low pressure well south and the high pressure to the east keeps the winds on the slightly strong side with terrain induced winds continuing in port.
