

APPROACHING FROM THE WEST ALONG THE ANTARCTIC COASTLINE TOMORROW. THIS LOW WILL BRING ABOUT A WIND SHIFT, AND WILL SUSTAIN THE
CLOUDINESS, FOG, AND PRECIPITATION THROUGH THE END OF THE PERIOD. A MODERATE, GUSTY WIND WILL ALSO PICK UP AGAIN, MAINTAINING SIG WAVE
HEIGHTS THROUGH BOTH TODAY AND TOMORROW.
