

28-Feb High pressure ridging continues to build across your current charted route. Cloudy conditions continue as there will be periods of rain, fog and/or **METSIT 06Z** rain and fog, especially as temperatures warm moving north. As the high pressure ridge builds a large low pressure system slides south, winds pick up significantly and larger waves just S-SE.
