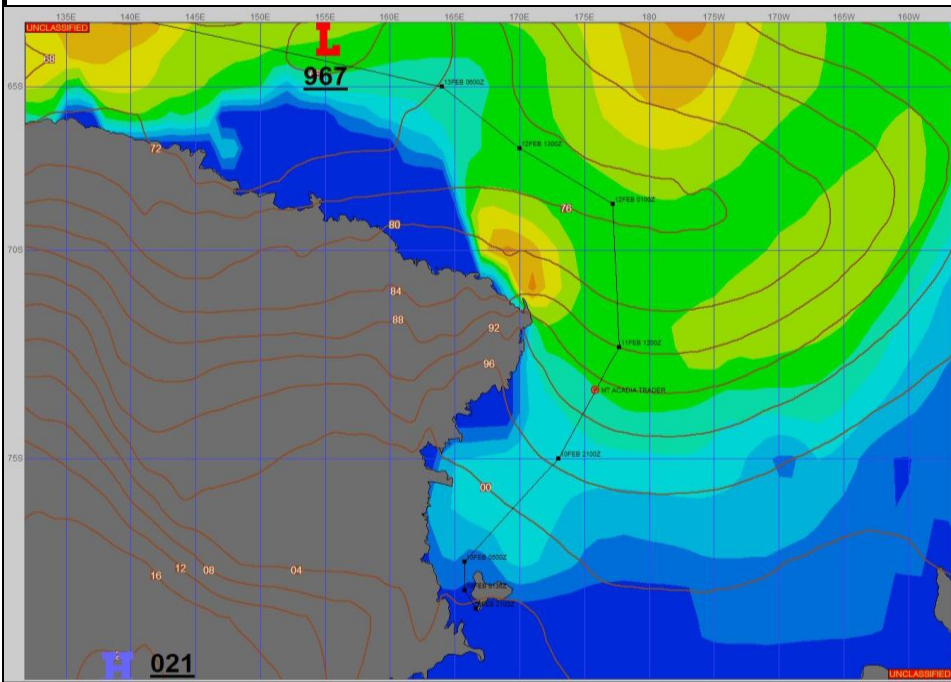


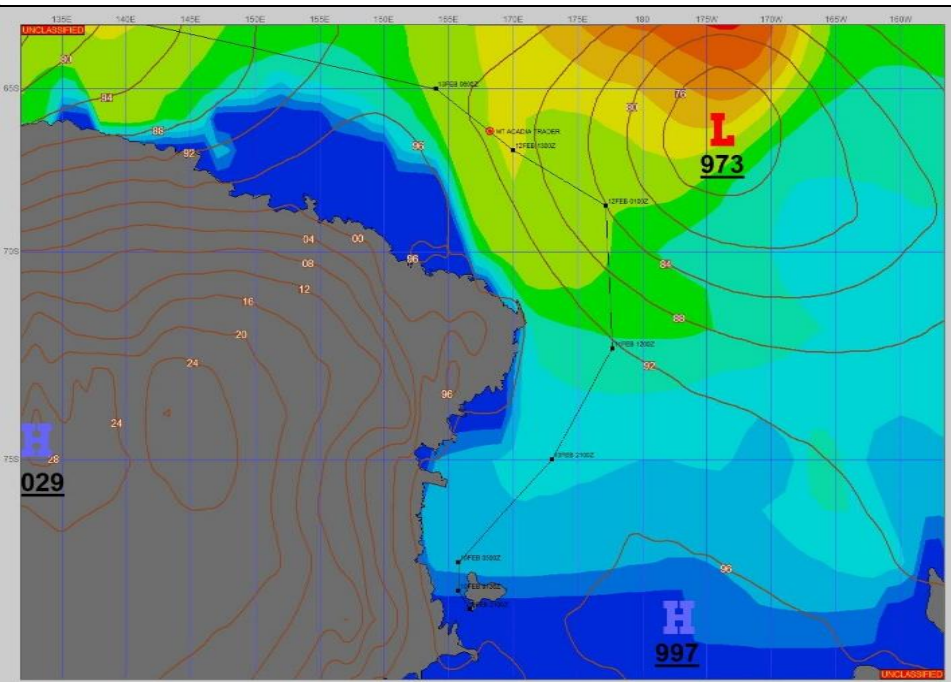

A 967MB LOW OFF THE GEORGE COAST EXTENDS A TROUGH OVER THE ROSS SEA PRODUCING EXTENSIVE CLOUD COVER AND GUSTY WINDS. EXPECT MOSTLY CLOUDY TO CLOUDY SKIES WITH VISIBILITY SIGNIFICANTLY REDUCED IN SNOW AND FOG. NEAR GALE WINDS WILL DECREASE TO A FRESH BREEZE BY 12Z ON THE 12TH. ROUGH SEAS ARE FORECAST TO PEAK AT 11-15FT AROUND THE SAME TIME AND GRADUALLY TAPER OFF THROUGH THE REMAINDER OF THE FORECAST.
