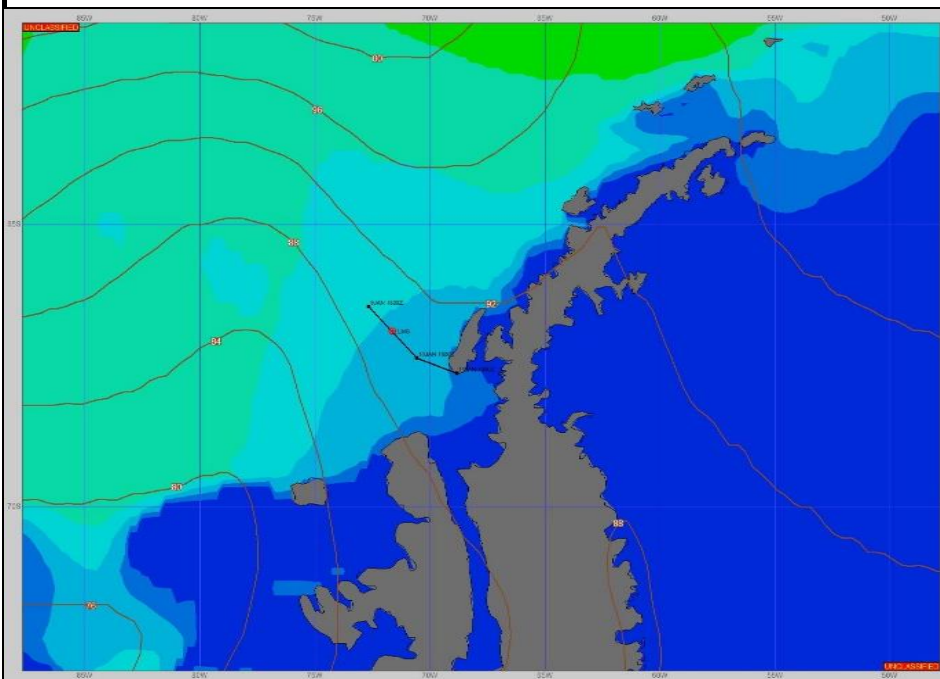


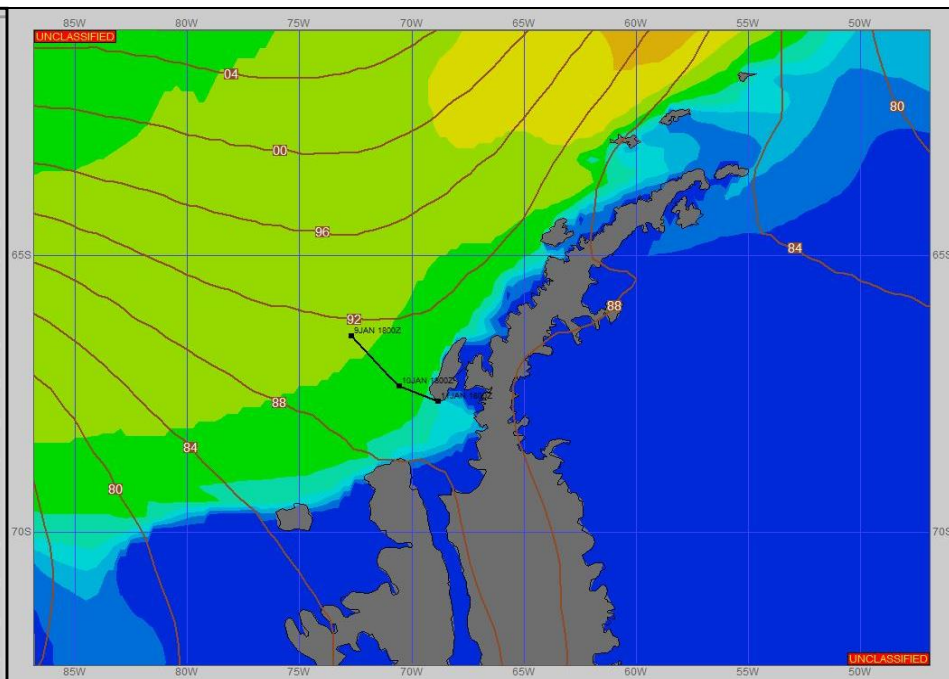

A 958MB LOW EXITING THE AMUNDSEN SEA EXTENDS A TROUGH ALONG THE COAST OF THE BELLINGSHUAZEN SEA AND SOUTHERN PORTIONS OF THE ANTARCTIC PENINSULA. INTERACTION BETWEEN THIS TROUGH AND A RIDGE THAT EXTENDS OVER THE NORTHERN PORTION OF THE ANTARCTIC PENINSULA ALLOWS FOR A LONG FETCH ACROSS THE BELLINGSHAUSEN SEA, WITH RELATIVELY STRAIT-LINE MODERATE WINDFLOW. EXPECT CLOUDY SKYS WITH MIXED SNOW, RAIN AND FOG, A MODERATE TO FRESH BREEZE AND MODERATE SEAS FOR THE NEXT FEW DAYS.
