



METSIT 06Z 1-Dec The passing low pressure system is strengthened by a strong high pressure system passing across New Zealand. The steep pressure gradient will persist in the Southern Ocean area along the route as the low continues to evolve and slowly progress westwards, causing severe weather across an impressive latitude span. Expect high winds, periods of rough seas, and reduced visibility due to mixed precipitation and fog along the route northwards.

FORECASTER NOTES Positions are estimated from the 28NOV24 MOVEREP and previous SITREPS; the 29 NOV 2024 SITREP does not contain the ship's updated estimated locations for the next 48 hours.
