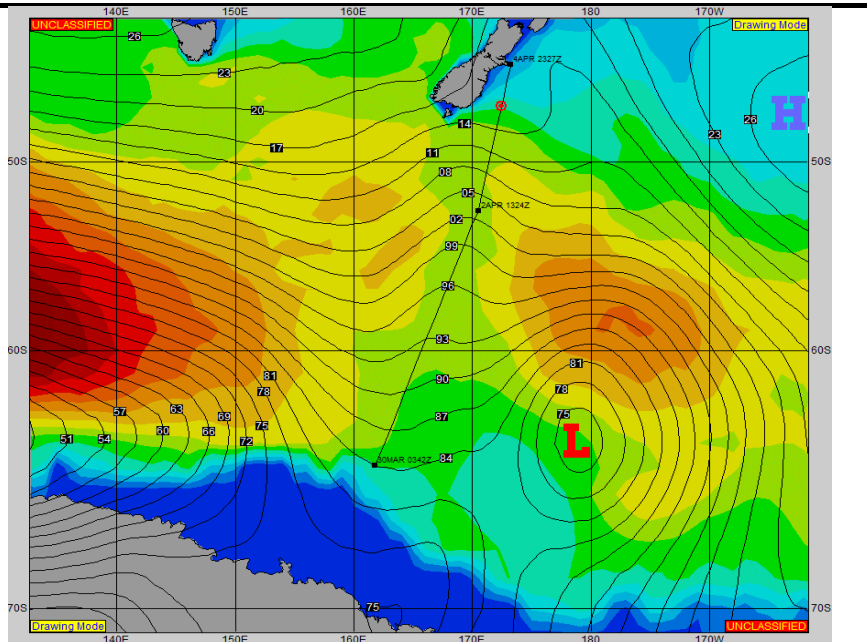
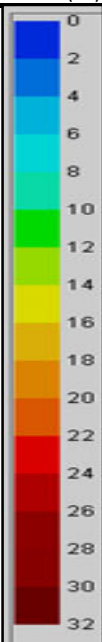
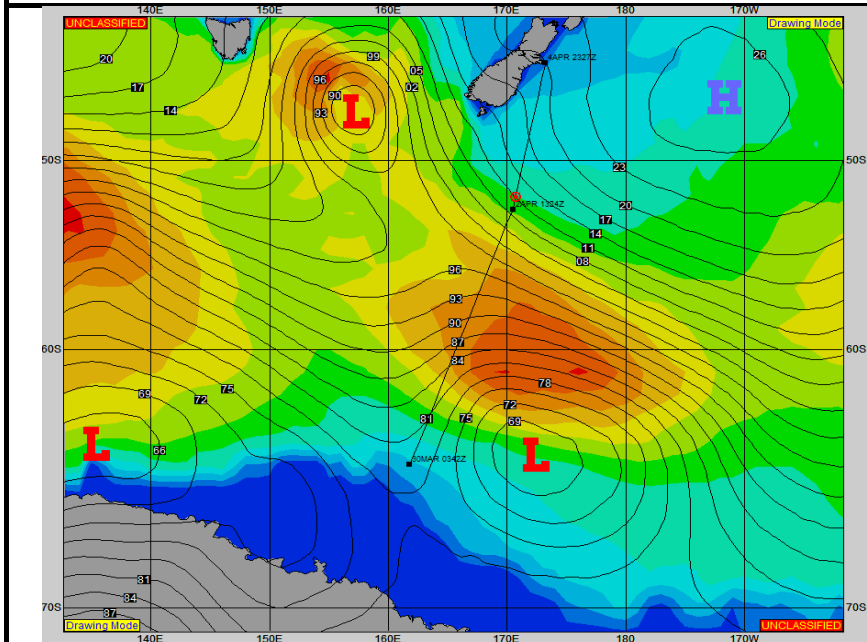

A pair of lows and a strong high will cause high wind gusts from the North. As the low moves southwards past the South Island, it will cause a shift in the wave direction, maintaining moderate wave heights. As the boat progresses towards New Zealand, winds and waves will taper off while the edge of a squall associated with a passing low causes light rain showers.
