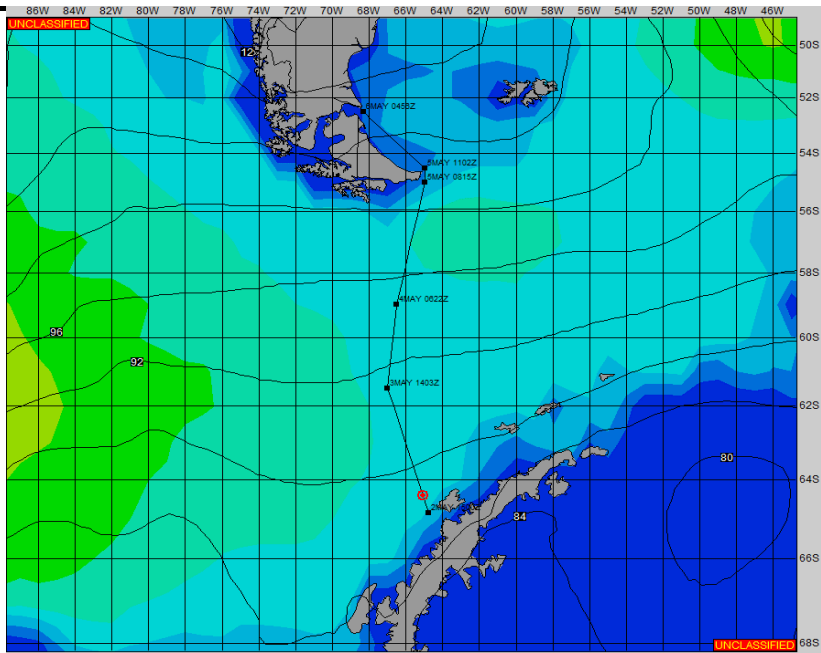

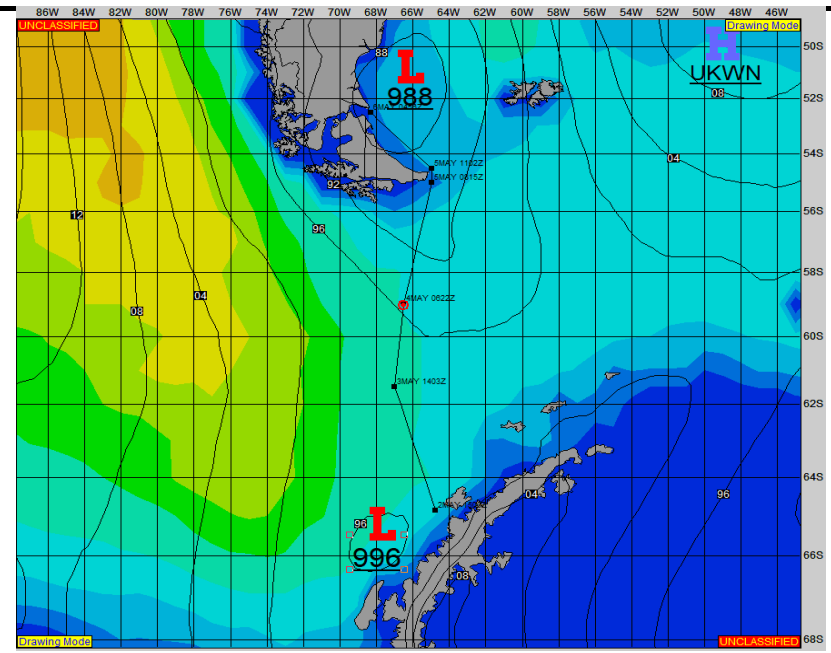

METSIT 21Z 2-May Low pressure will track across the Bellingshausen Sea towards the Antarctic Peninsula. The low will weaken as it approaches, but will still bring areas of precipitation as it dissipates. This low will not bring significant waves heights and winds as it continues to weaken. As the vessel approaches Chile, a low will move down the Argentinian coast and cause winds to increase along with heavy rain.
