



**4-Mar** Today snow and vicinity snow showers are expected from a weak trough extending from a low pressure system in the north of the Ross Sea. A weak low pressure system develops as the trough pulls away, causing more cloud cover and precipitation to develop along the boat's route. Lack of significant flow could set conditions for fog development, particularly accompanying the snow.
