



METSIT 21Z 5-Mar With a relatively stagnant flow present, predominately light winds will affect the boat's last reported position. A weak low will drive overcast conditions and generate snowfall causing periods of restricted visibility due to snow and parital fog throughout the forecast period. Lack of high winds will also help keep wave heights low for the next two days.
