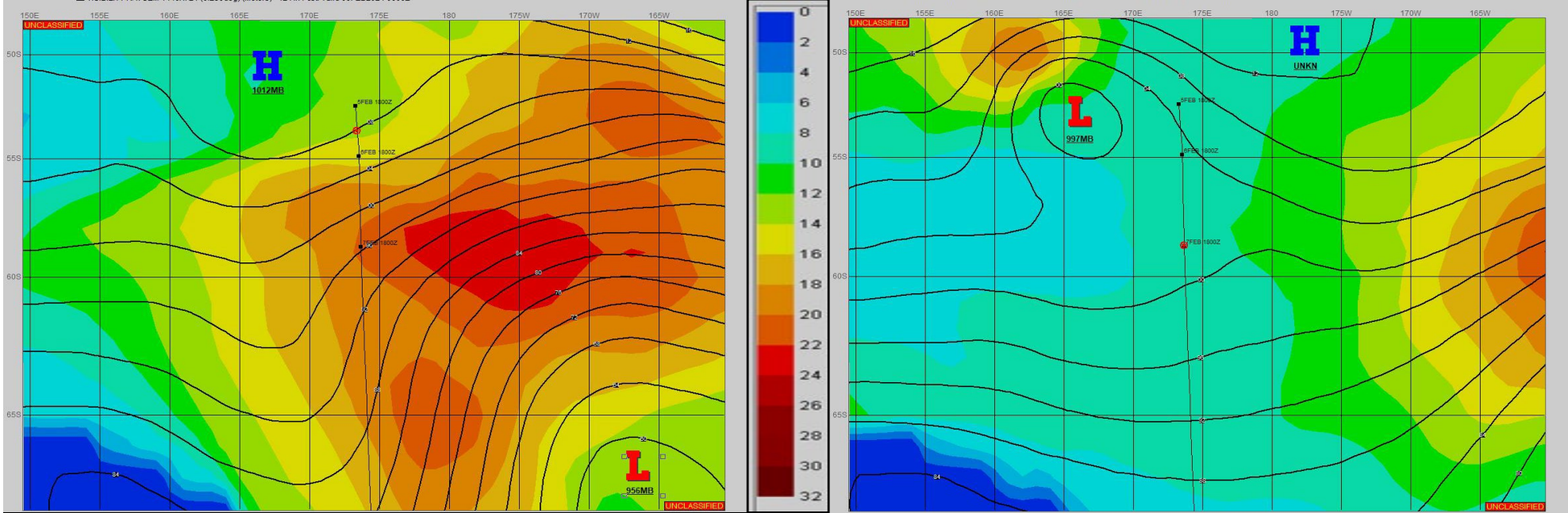

METSIT 06Z 6-Feb HIGHEST SEAS EMBEDDED IN THE TIGHT GRADIENT BETWEEN THE HIGH AND LOW MOVE EAST. SEAS WILL FALL GRADUALLY FROM 06/1800Z. A WEAK LOW PRESSURE TROUGH IN THE WESTERLY FLOW WILL INCREASE WIND SPEEDS AND REDUCE VISIBILITY IN RAIN AND FOG FROM APPROXIMATELY 07/0600Z THROUGH 07/1500Z.
