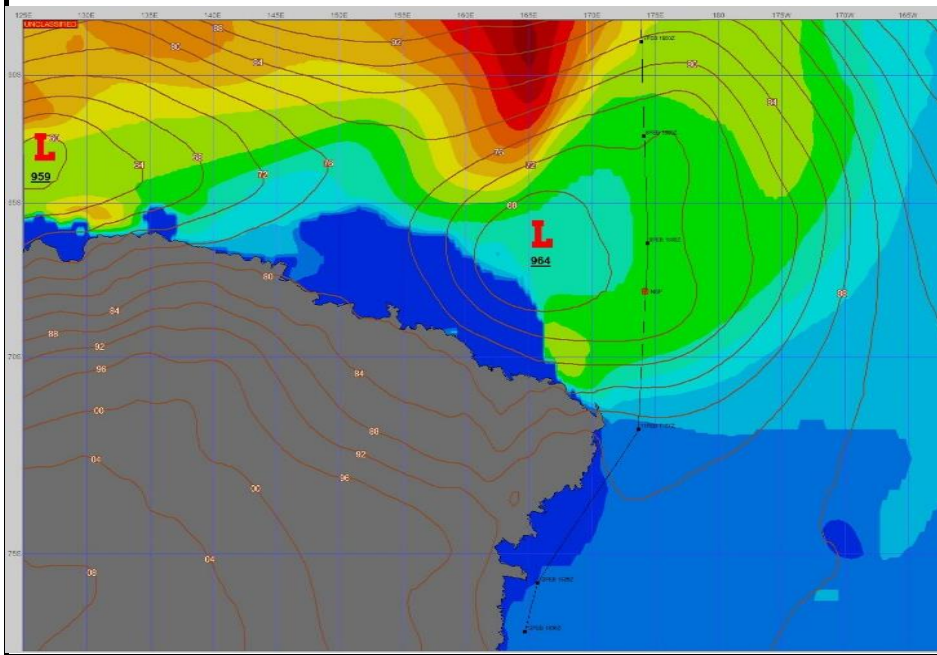


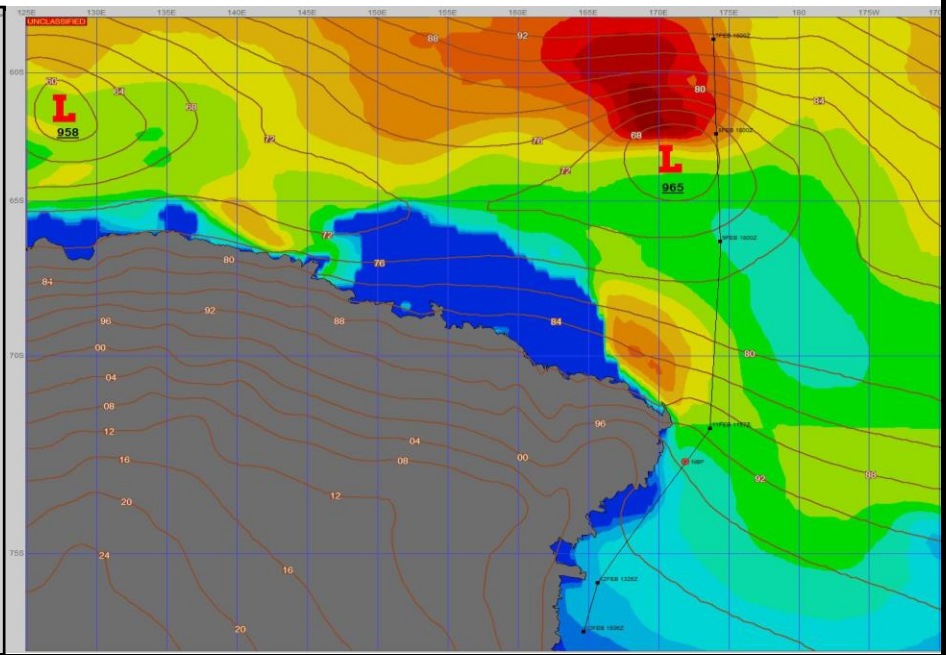

METSIT 06Z 10-Feb A 964MB LOW NEAR 67S 165E IS CREATING A STRONG PRESSURE GRADIENT, CAUSING STRONG WINDS FROM THE NORTHEAST. AN OCCCLUDED FRONTAL BOUNDARY IS BISECTS THE ROUTE. STRONG WINDS ARE NOT EXPECTED TO MARKEDLY DECREASE UNTIL SOUTH OF CAPE HALLETT, HOWEVER INCREASED WINDS WILL PERSIST WITHIN 60NM OF THE COASTLINE. EXPECT REDUCED VISIBILITIES DUE TO BLOWING SNOW AND FOG TIL APPROX 12/06Z.
