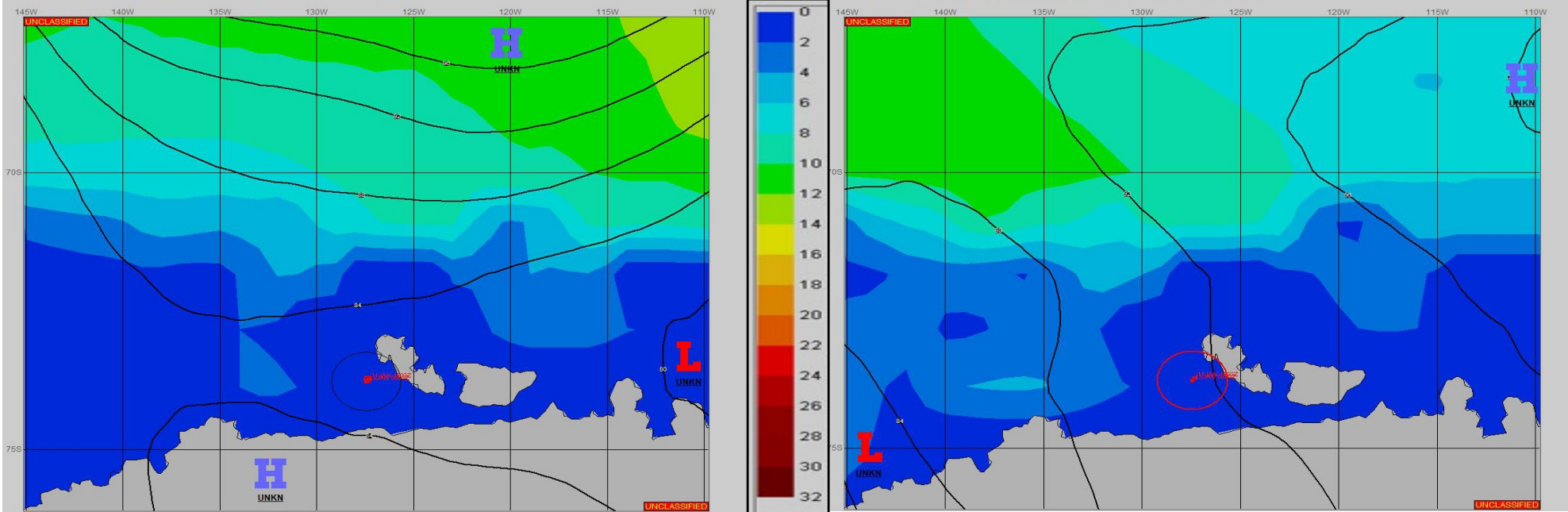

METSIT 06Z 12-Jan A 958MB LOW DROPPING SOUTH BETWEEN 165W AND 160W TOWARDS THE EASTERN ROSS ICE SHELF WILL MOVE A TROUGH/FONTAL BOUNDARY WITH ASSOCIATED REDUCED VISIBILITY IN PRECIPITATION/FOG, AND HIGHER WIND THROUGH THE OPERATIONS AREA FROM 13/0000Z THROUGH 13/1500Z. CONDITIONS WILL EASE THROUGH THE END OF THE PERIOD WITH LINGERING CLOUDS AND FOG.

FORECASTER NOTES WINDS MAY DIFFER FROM THOSE FORECAST DUE TO FUNNELING/SHELTERING EFFECTS OF ISLANDS.
