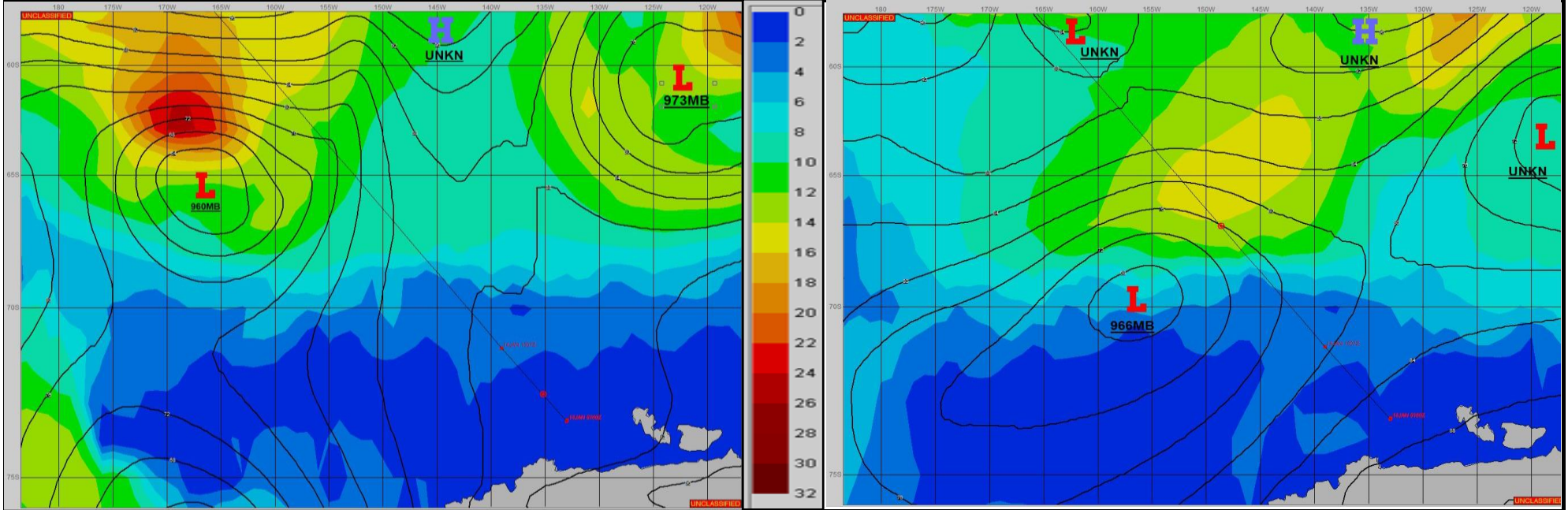

METSIT 06Z 14-Jan A 960MB LOW NEAR 66S 167W MOVING SE WITH ASSOCIATED FRONTAL BOUNDARY WILL CONTINUE TO FILL AND MOVE SE PARALLEL TO THE ROUTE. VISIBILITY WILL REMAIN POOR THROUGH THE FORECAST PERIOD IN PRECIPITATION AND FOG CHANGING TO MIXED BY END OF PERIOD AS TEMPERATURES GRADUALLY WARM. WINDS WILL BEGIN LIGHT BUT INCREASE QUICKLY BY 14/18Z AND SWING AROUND FROM ENE TO WSW BY END OF PERIOD WITH STRONGEST WINDS GUSTING UP TO 30KT FROM WNW AT NEAREST PROXIMITY TO THE LOW CENTER NEAR 67S 148W AROUND 15/18Z.
