

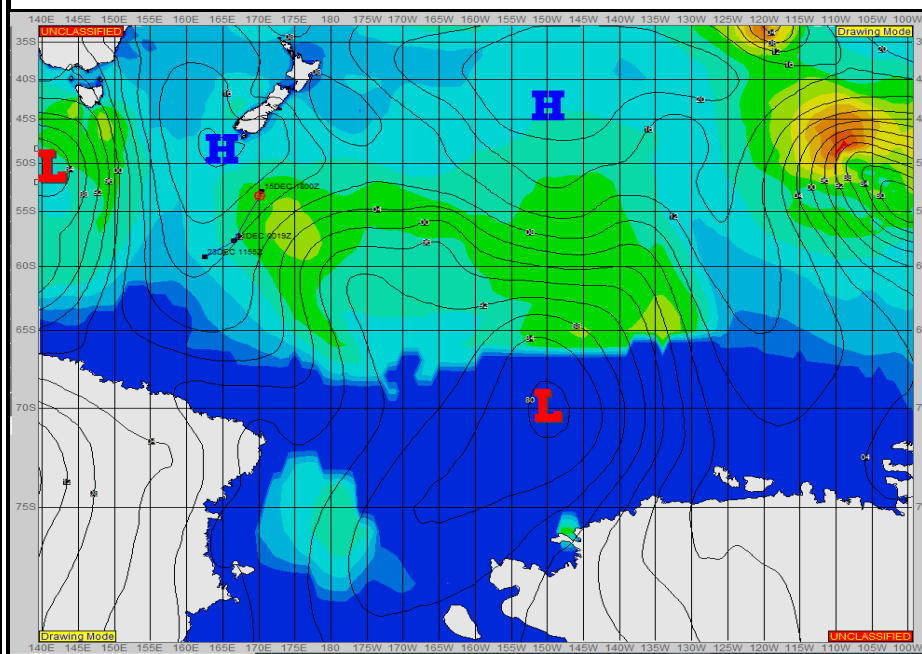

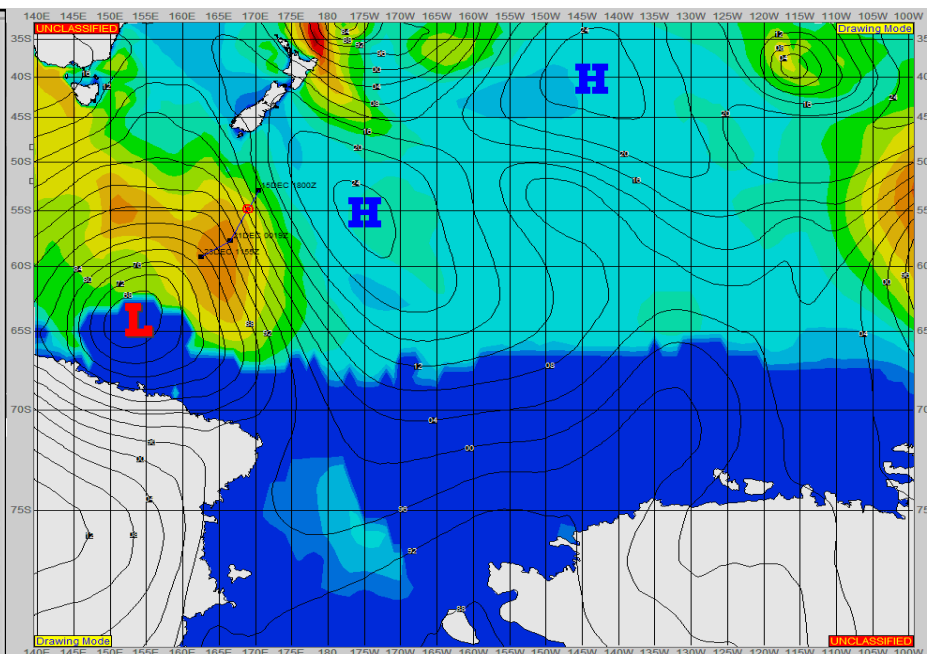

METSIT 06Z 16-Dec The region is dominated by high pressure initially and as such, you can expect pretty favorable conditions for operations at the 06Z point. By 18Z a dynamic transitory low pressure system will pass by to the SW of the ship's route and subsequently provide more significant waves, stronger winds, and some adverse weather in the way of visibility.
