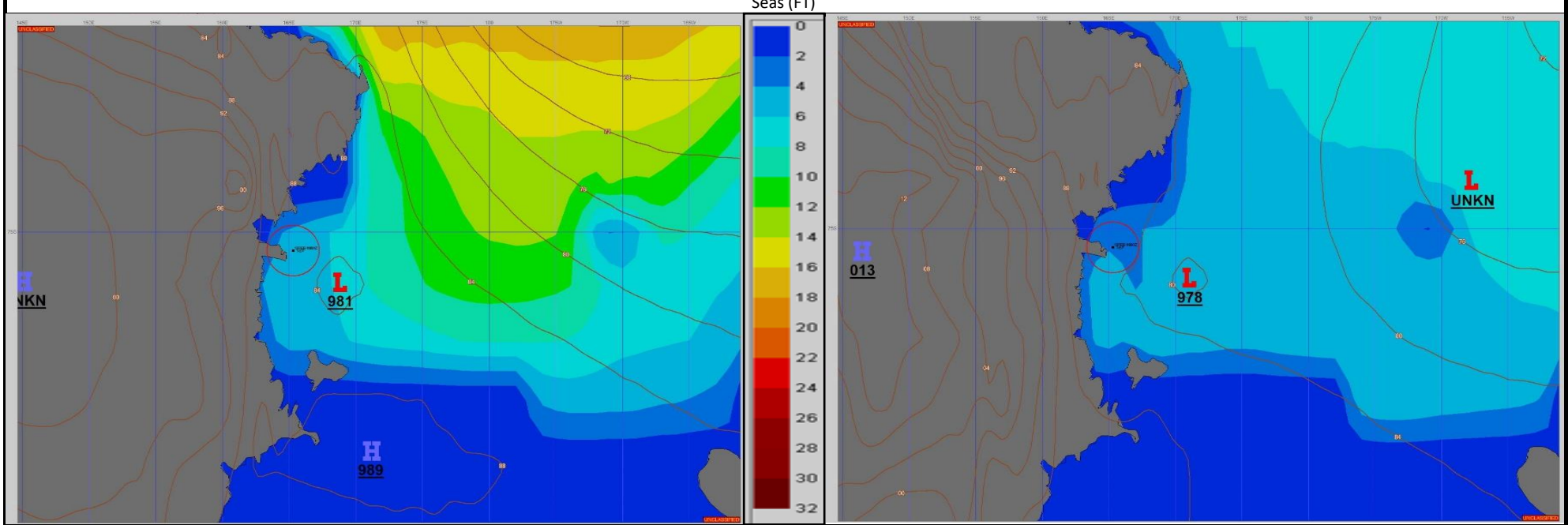

METSIT 06Z 16-Feb HIGH PRESSURE SPILLS OFF THE PRODUCING PARTLY CLOUDY SKIES IN THE VICINITY OF THE DRYGALSKI ICE TONGUE. EXPECT FAIR CONDITIONS UNTIL AROUND 17/06Z WHEN MOISTURE IS PUSHED UP THROUGH THE MCMURDO SOUND AND OVER YOUR AREA. THE FORECAST IS FOR A GENTLE TO MODERATE BREEZE BECOMING FRESH TO STRONG AFTER 17/20Z. UNRESTRICTED VISIBILITY WITH PERIODS OF FOG AND SNOW REDUCING VISIBILITY 18/00Z.

FORECASTER NOTES Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of The Drygalski Ice Tongue.
