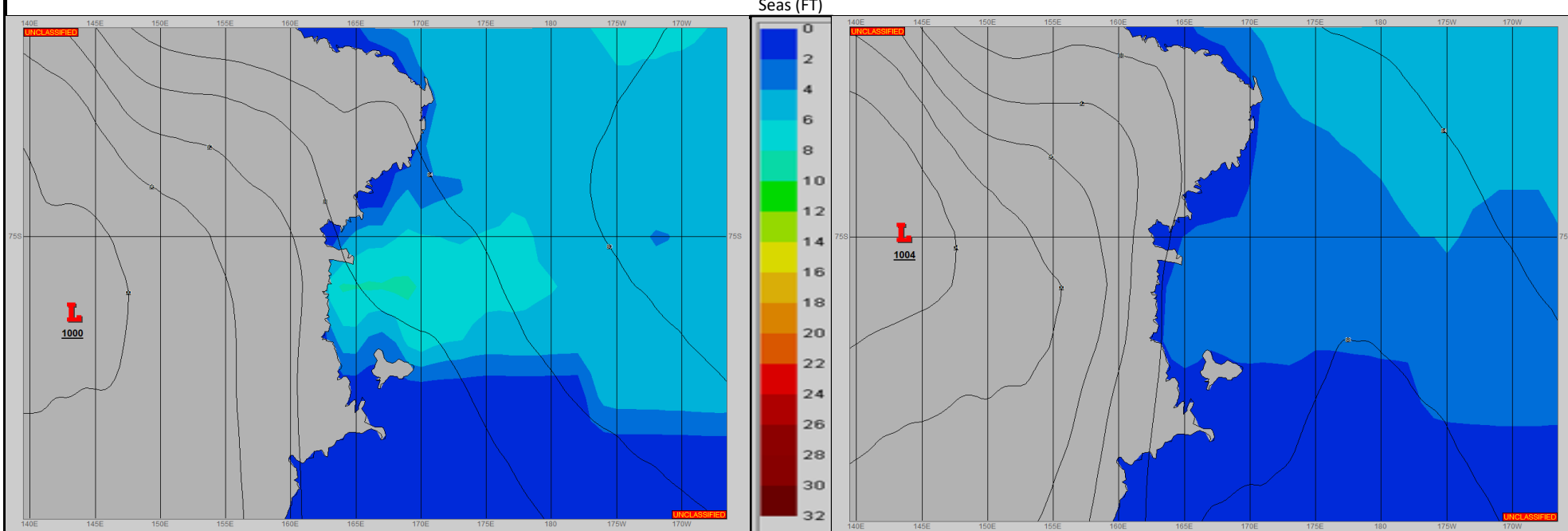

METSIT 06Z 18-Feb THE WEATHER PATTERN REMAINS UNDISTURBED BY ANY SIGNIFICANT MIGRATORY SYSTEMS, EXPECT CONDITIONS TO REMAIN STAGNANT DURING THE EARLY PERIOD AND THEN CLOUD COVER AND FOG CLEARING UP AS WINDS SHIFT FROM SE TO SW. THE CUT OFF LOW PRESSURE CENTER WEST OF YOUR LOCATION IS SLOWLY FILLING SO EXPECT RELATIVELY CALM WINDS AND CALM SEAS.

FORECASTER NOTES Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of The Drygalski Ice Tongue.
