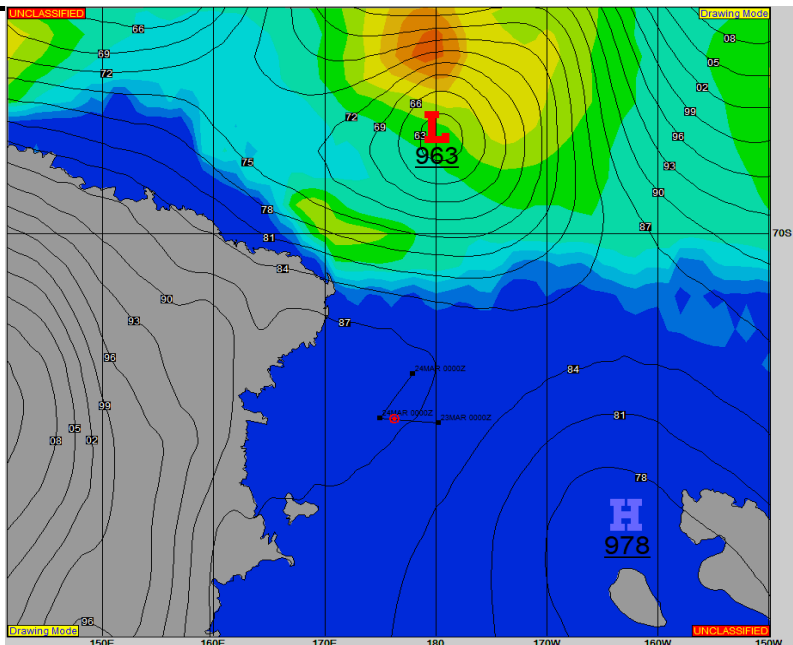

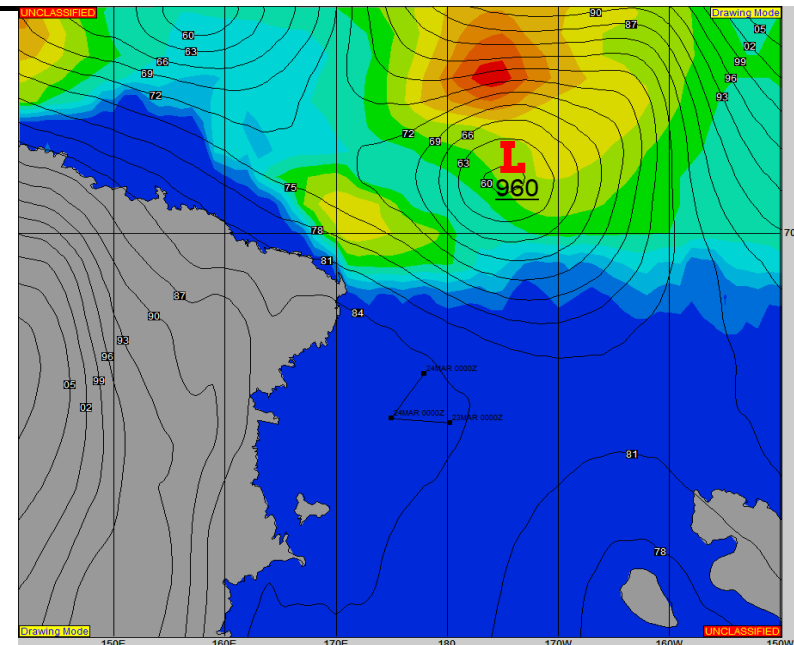

METSIT 21Z 23-Mar A low pressure center will move in from the north throughout the forecast period. As the low approaches, the pressure gradient will tighten and bring in strong winds from the south. The low will bring in clouds in the mid levels, but no precipitation is expected with this system. Fog will begin to move into the ship route from the south towards the end of the forecast period.
