



**METSIT 21Z**25-Mar The low pressure system moving form the Ross Sea onto the Ice Shelf will draw away from the ship's estimated position. Winds will taper off as a high pressure system develops around the boat. Once the boat begins heading north, a large low will begin into the Ross Sea, elevating winds and drawing in cloud cover along the route.
