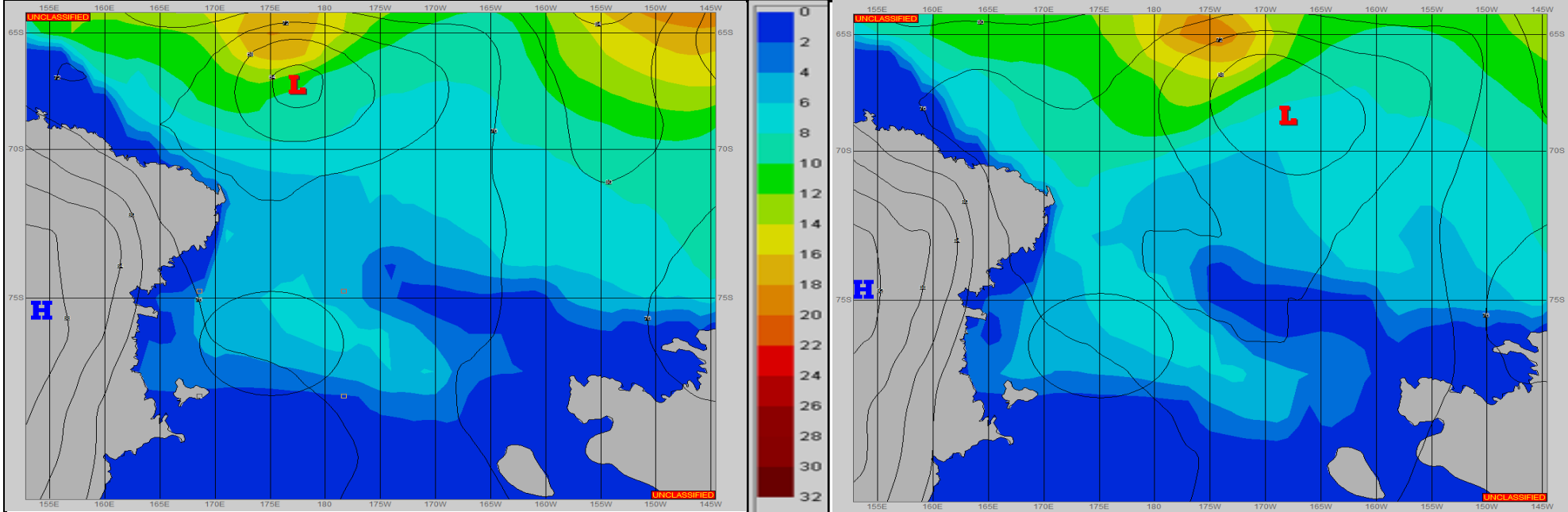

METSIT 06Z 28-Feb A 968MB LOW PRESSURE CENTER HANGING OUT IN THE ROSS SEA WITH WILL SLOWLY START TO WEAKEN AND MOVE SOUTH. I HIGH PRESSURE SYSTEM IS SADDLED OVER EASTERN ANTARCTICA AND IS NOT EXPECTED TO GIVE WAY TO ANY MIGRATORY SYSTEMS AND SHOULD BE THE PREDOMINANT WEATHER FEATURE BRINGING FAVORABLE CONDITIONS THROUGHOUT THE PERIOD WITH OCCASIONAL LIGHT SNOW EARLY IN THE PERIOD AS MINOR PERTURBATIONS MIGRATE AROUND THE LOW.
