



**METSIT 12Z 16-Jan** Generally fair weather today as a low center makes its way eastward and away from your route - but temperatures will be dropping as you progress southward. Another low awaits along the Southern Ocean / Ross Sea boundary, this one likely to bring a swing in the component to winds and seas tomorrow, along with light mixed precipitation and patchy fog.
