



High pressure continues to hold strong over northern Victoria Land and ridging over your OPAREA producing fair weather and partly cloudy skies, with localized areas of sea smoke and fog. Low pressure to the NE of Cape Adare will transit to the eastern Ross Sea. As has been the trend, the high pressure over Victoria Land will build through the period supporting continued strong glacial outflow winds over and north of the Drygalski Ice Tongue, northern portions of your mod-loc, and the Terra Nova Bay area. Areas of mostly cloudy skies and snow may be expected downstream of the outflow winds, most likely in the northern OPAREA, Terra Nova Bay, and Cape Washington areas. Forecast below is for the center of your MODLOC.

## FORECASTER NOTES

Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands and katabatic winds off glaciers.
