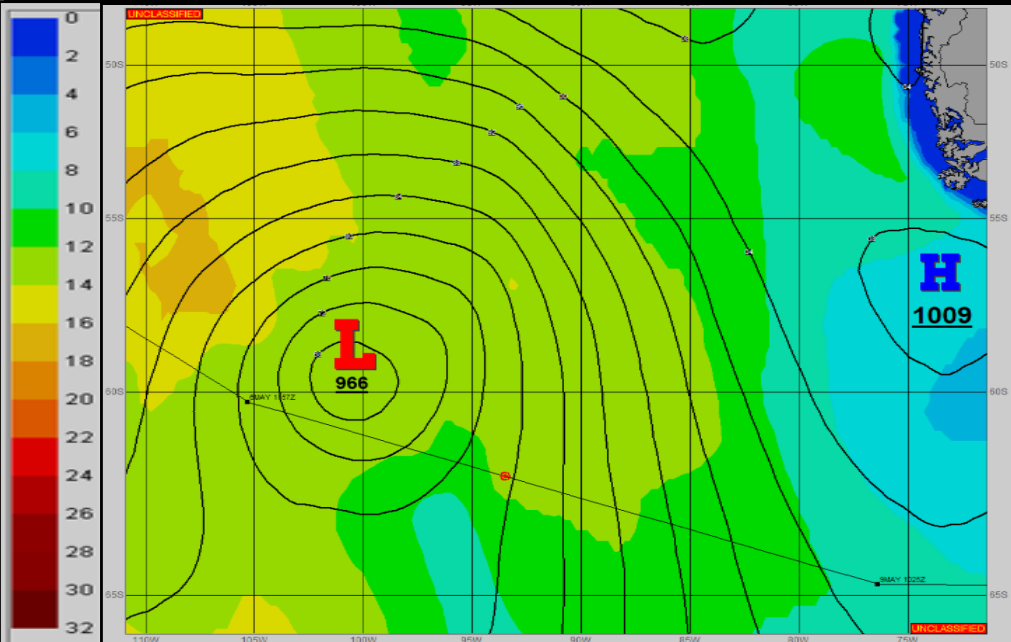
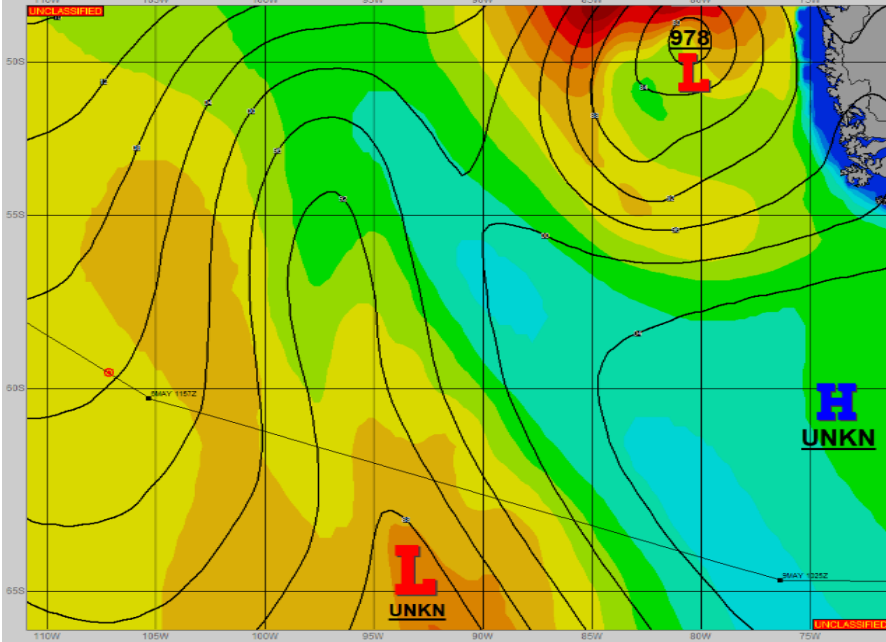

METSIT 06Z 6-May PATCHY FOG WITH RELATIVELY LIGHT WINDS EXPECTED THROUGH THE START OF THE PERIOD. NEAR THE MIDDLE TO THE END OF THE PERIOD, A LOW PRESSURE SYSTEM COMING IN FROM THE WEST STARTS ENCROUCHING IN ON THE ROUTE CAUSING RAIN, GUSTY WINDS, AND LOWERED VISIBILITY.
