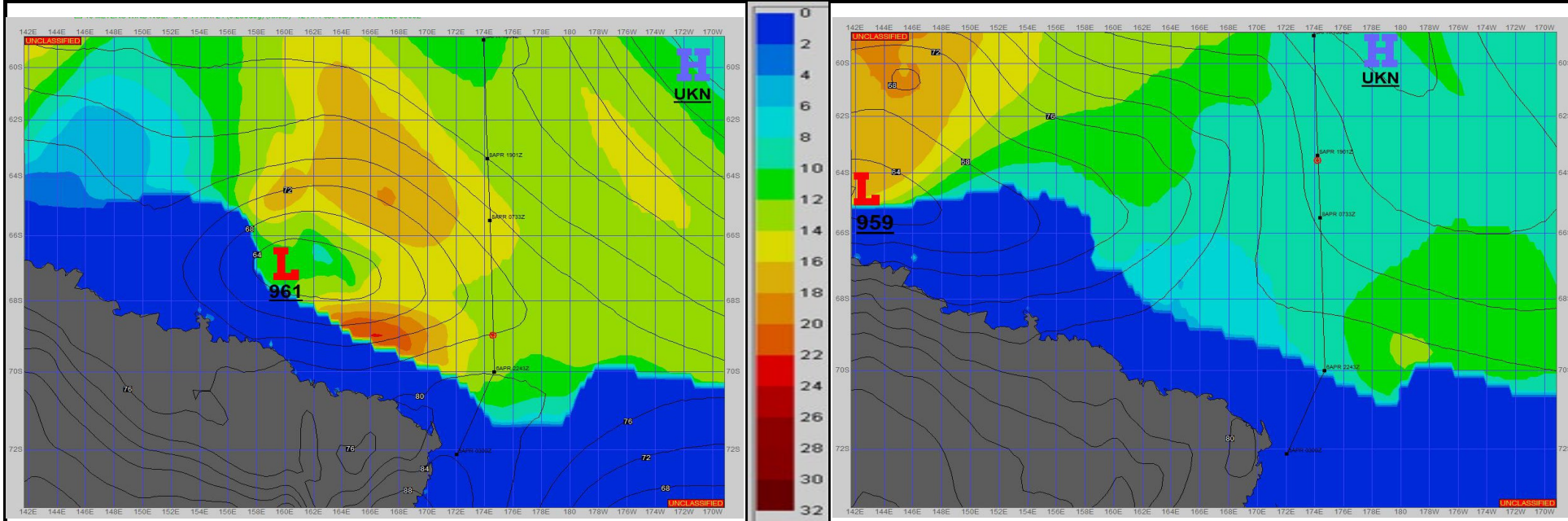

High pressure in the South Pacific is blocking the movement of low pressure in the Southern Sea. Upon crossing the frontal boundary just ahead of your vessel's position, winds and seas will back to the northwest, then gradually decrease during the forecast period. After 09/00Z the low will deepen again increasing northerly gusts and seas midway through the outlook period.

FORECASTER NOTES

Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands and katabatic winds off glaciers.
