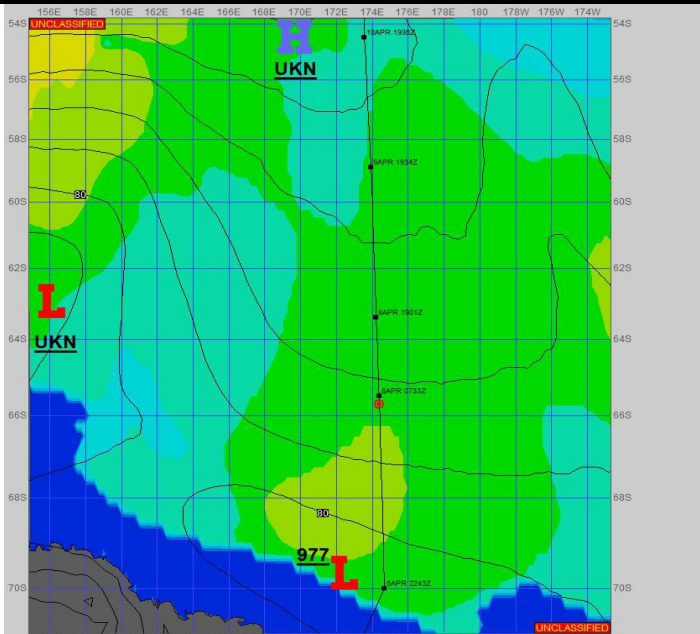

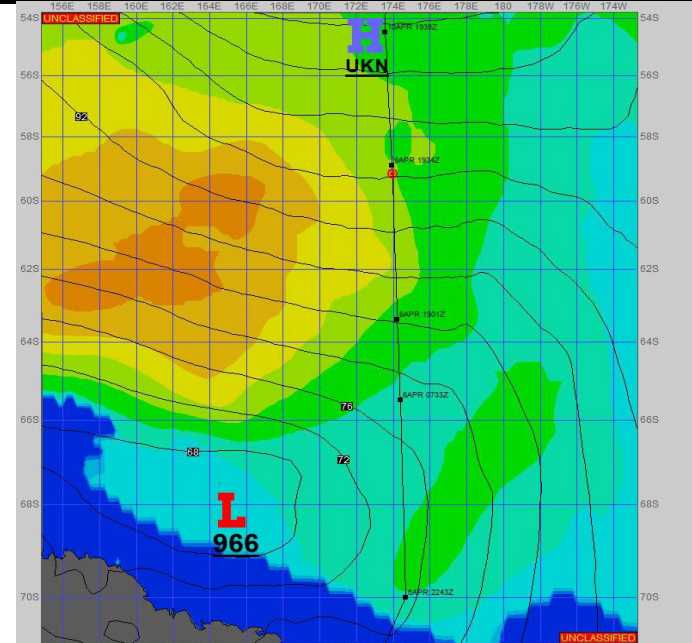

High pressure in the South Pacific is weakening and moving east allowing the front associated with low pressure to your SE to cross your track. Winds will shift from the North to the West/Northwest as a new high pressure center builds from the Tasman Sea and will ridge to the east of your track producing strong winds and seas from the west-northwest, (on your beam) for much of the outlook period.

FORECASTER NOTES

Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands and katabatic winds off glaciers.
