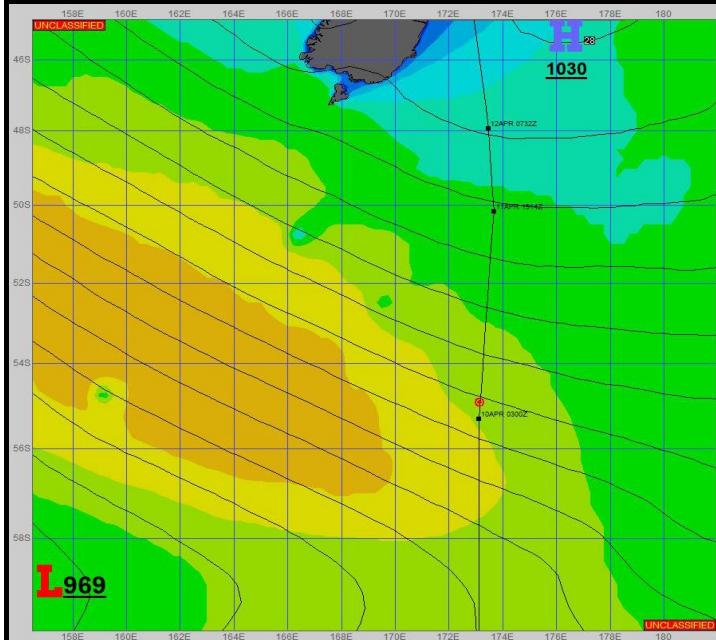

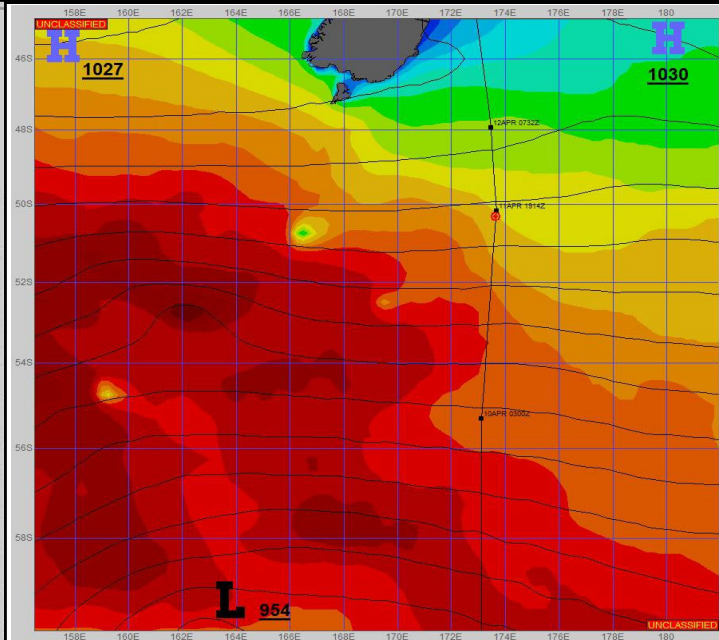

High pressure splits to the west and east of New Zealand and interacts with low pressure off the Antarctic coast and will continue to produce persistent West through North-Northwest winds and seas. The low pressure system will rapidly deepen and move east increasing winds to Near Gale force mid period, gradually diminishing in the outlook period.
