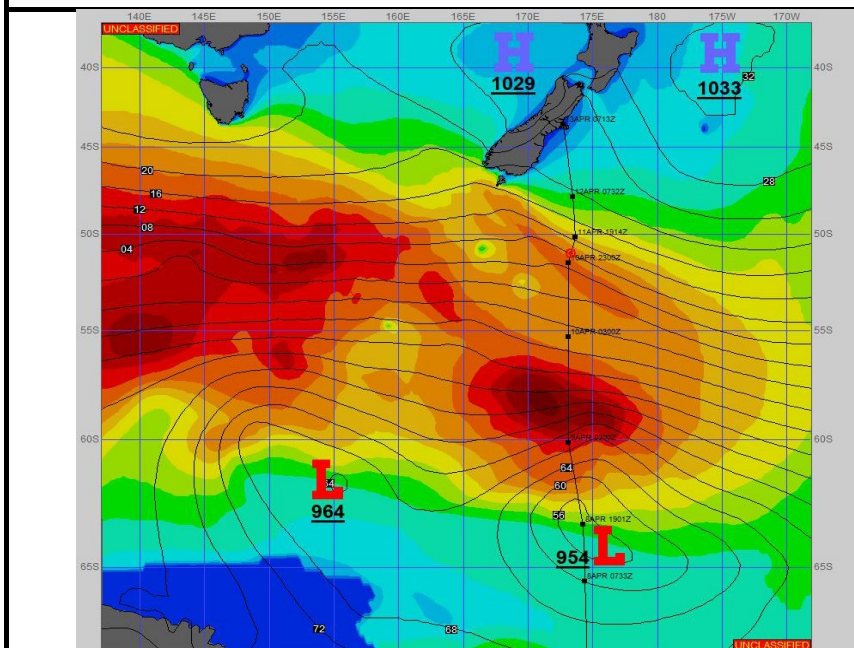

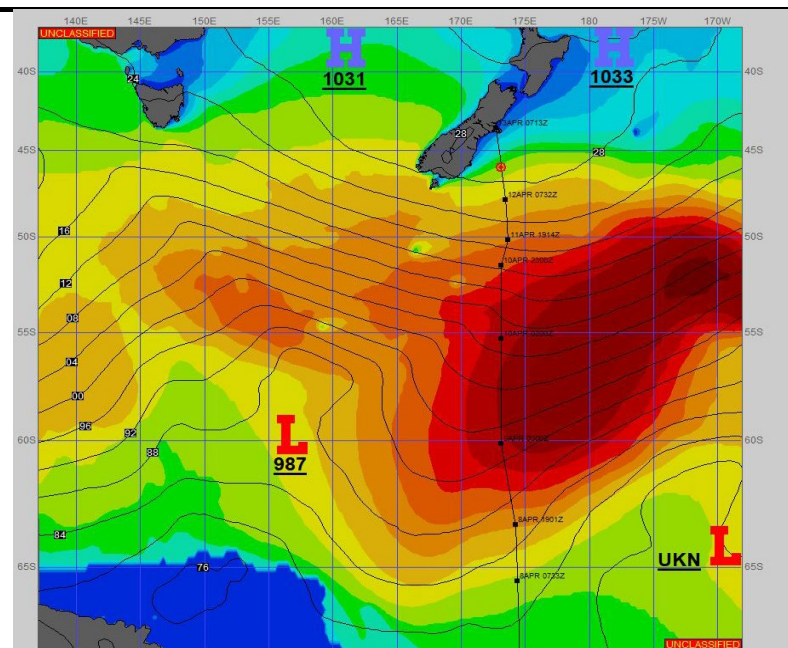

METSIT 06Z 11-Apr High pressure over the Tasman Seas nad New Zealand interacts with low pressure off the Antarctic coast and will continue to produce persistent West through North-Northwest winds and seas. High pressure to the east of NZ will produce Fresh NE breezes as you arrive to the east of the south Island in the outlook period.
