



METSIT 06Z 13-Mar The only thing constant going on, is the changing weather! Clouds continue to linger as low pressure eddies continue spin off of the plateau and/or off the shelf, around Ross Island. Continue to expect areas of light snow under the areas of thicker cloud cover. Gusty winds continue over the next day before decreasing for a short period. The next southerly storm blows through this weekend, while not as big as last weekends, expect those strong gusty southerly winds with some heavier snowfall along with it. Location will also determine strength of winds that could be felt.

FORECASTER NOTES Winds may differ from those forecast due to funneling/sheltering effects of islands and katabatic winds off glaciers.
