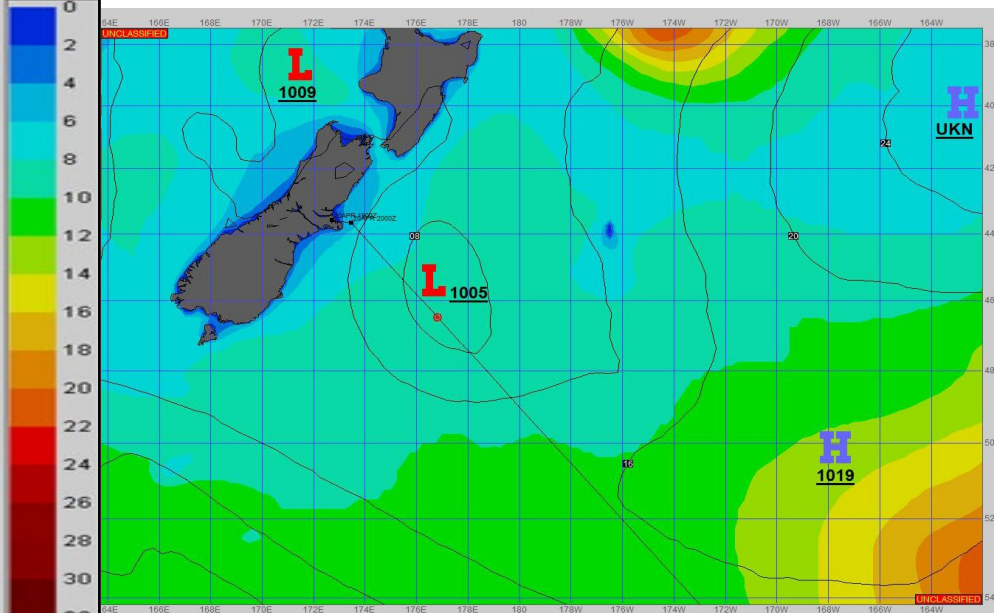
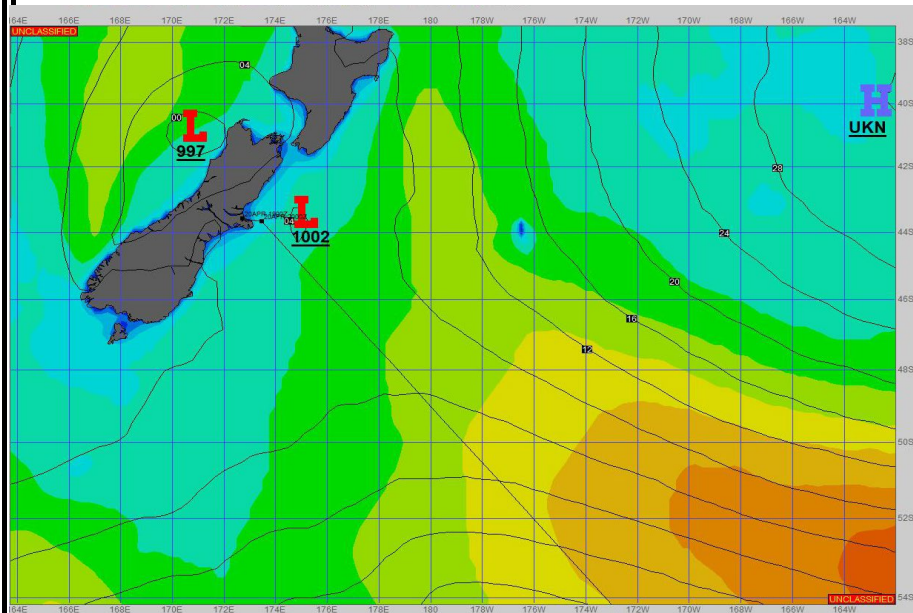

Low pressure and associated fronts over the South Island will produce cloudy skies with rain and fog over the region. The Port Hills will provide shelter from strongest winds inport early, becoming southerly as you enter open waters, and becoming variable at times as your track interacts with the frontal boundary over the outlook period.
