



22-Apr Low pressure and associated fronts extend from the east of New Zealand over your track and to the southeast producing cloudy skies and rain/fog along your track. Conditions will deteriorate as the pressure gradient tightens producing a long duration period of Near Gale to Gale force Southwest to Westerly winds and seas from the second half of the forecast period gradually tapering toward the end of the outlook period. SIG Waves and winds are expected to approach your limits.
