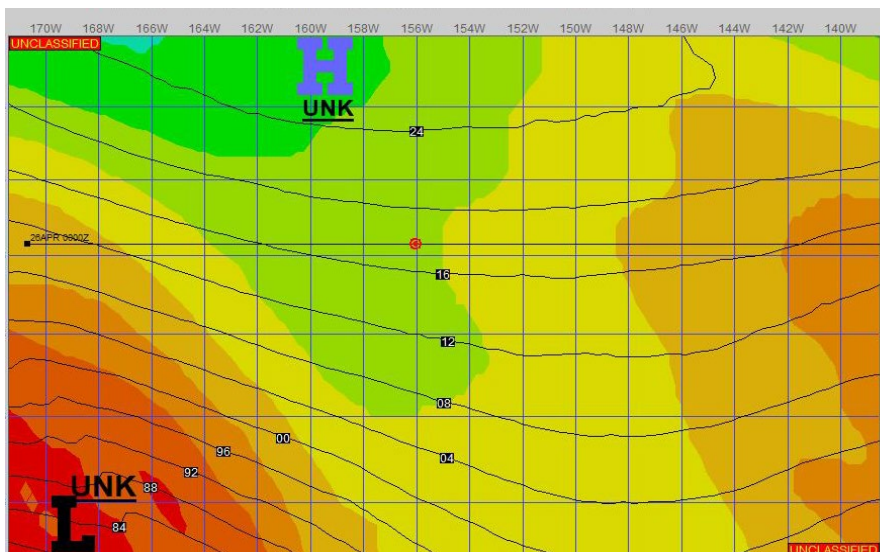

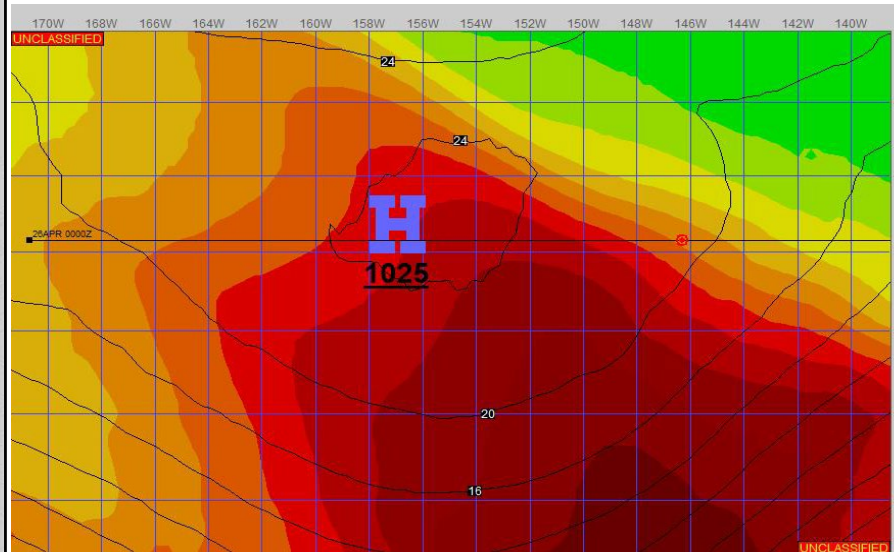

High pressure to your north is weakening ahead of a cold front approaching from the southwest and producing periods of light rain and mist ahead of the front. Expect seas to build from the NW ahead of the front, and continue to build and back to the SW following the frontal passage.
