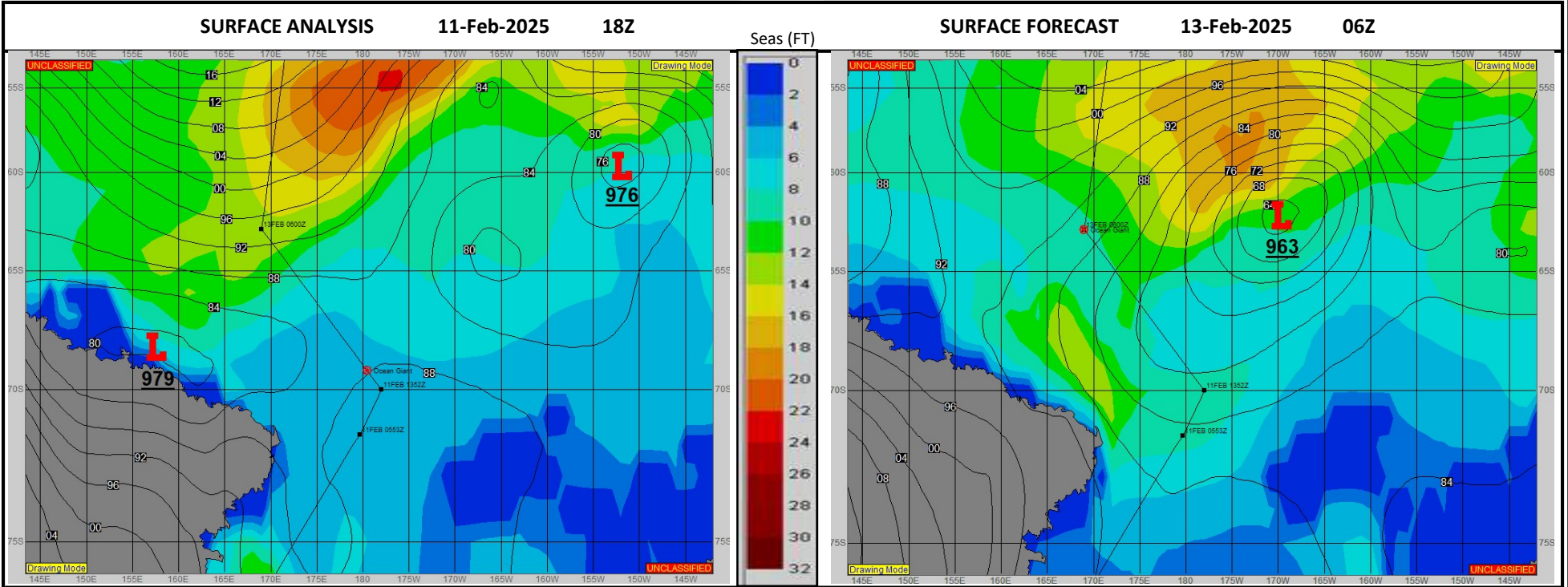

METSIT 18Z 11-Feb A low pressure center passes across the ship's route and extends its gradient partially into the Ross Sea. While the Ocean Giant should largely avoid the harshest conditions associated with the storm on the current path, still expect to encounter periods of moderate wind gusts. Fog and precipitation associated with the low will cause periodic visibility restrictions.
