

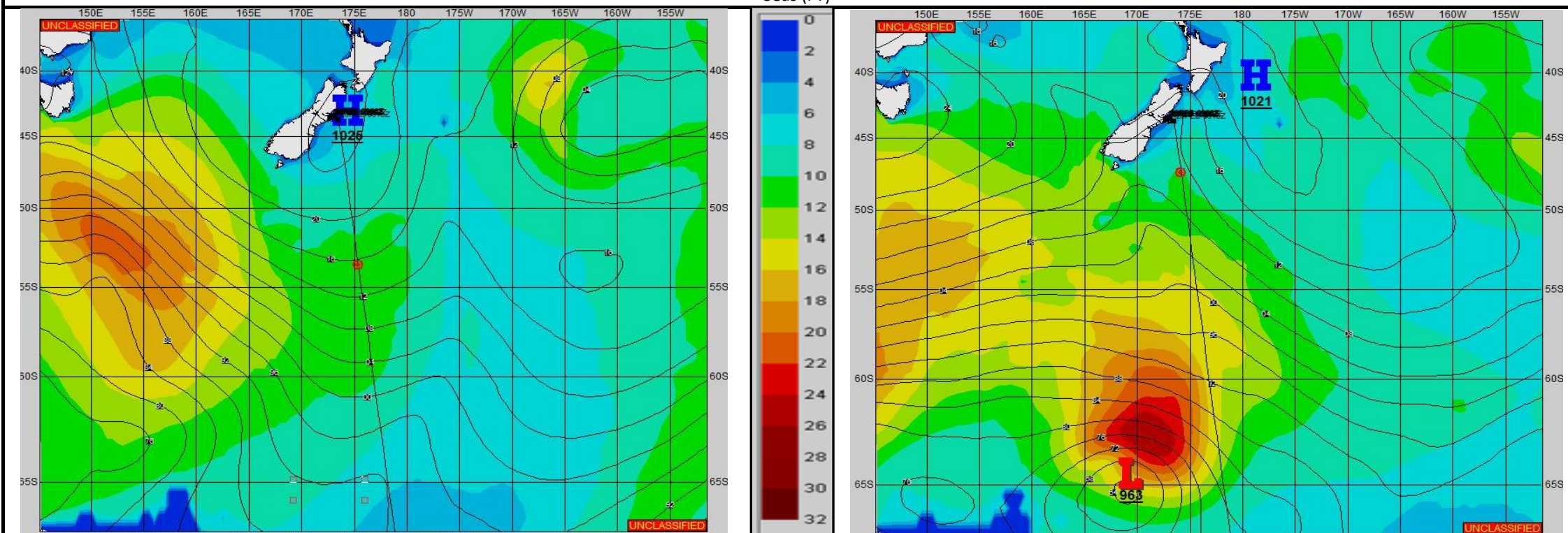

**METSIT 06Z 24-Feb** High pressure centered to the east of New Zealand builds a tight pressure gradient across the Southern Ocean with an adjacent low pressure system passing with a center around 65S. There will be a sudden wind shift in between the edge of the approaching cold front of the low pressure system and the high as the Plantijngracht approaches New Zealand. Sea fog is expected to reduce visibility along the route.
