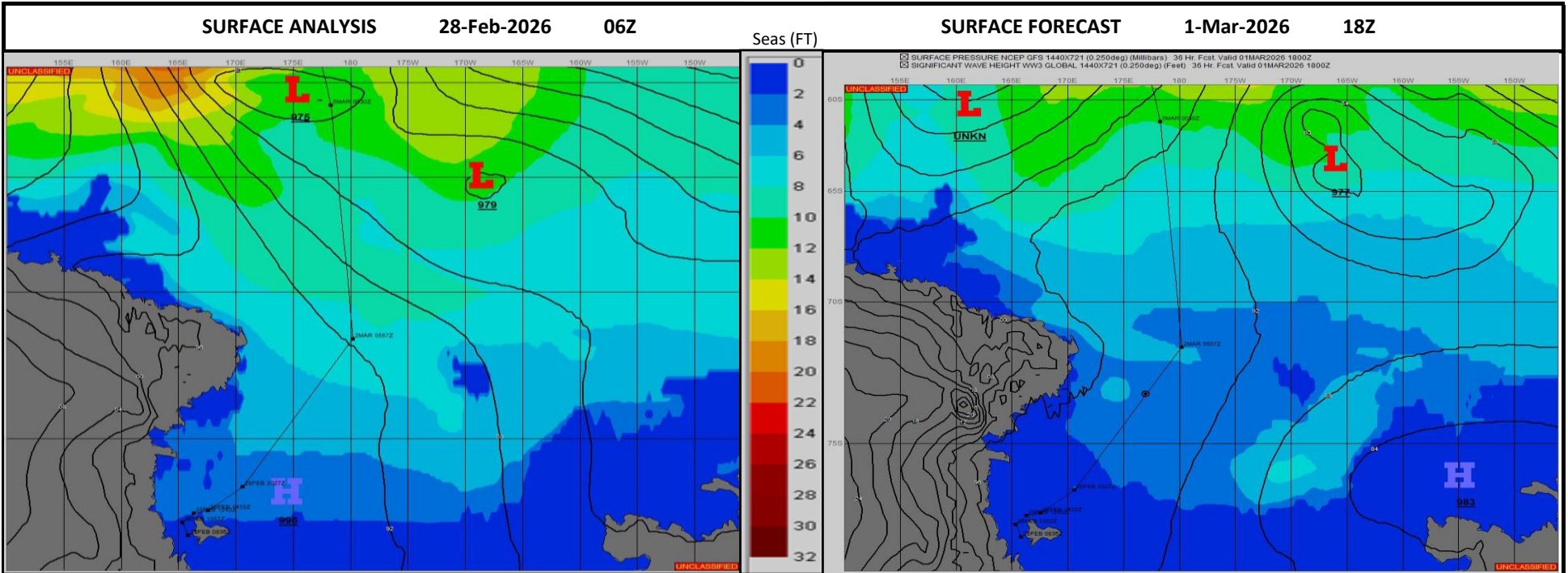

**METSIT 06Z 28-Feb** A HIGH PRESSURE CENTER NE OF ROSS ISLAND WILL PROVIDE FAVORABLE CONDITIONS. AS YOU HEAD NORTH THE HIGH WILL MOVE TO EAST AND YOU WILL BEGIN TO ENCOUNTER EFFECTS OF A 978MB LOW MOVING TO THE EAST OF YOUR ROUTE AND A SECOND 975MB LOW APPROACHING FROM THE WEST. YOUR TIMING SHOULD PLACE YOU BETWEEN STRONGEST AREAS OF WINDS ASSOCIATED WITH THE TWO LOW PRESSURE SYSTEMS BUT THERE WILL STILL BE A SIGNIFICANT AMOUNT OF PRECIP AND AND FOG ALONG YOUR ROUTE THROUGH THE FIRST 48 HOURS.
