The minimum temperature of -72.9 °C/-99.2 °F on the 11th broke the previous record of -72.4 °C/-98.3 °F set in 1999.

The maximum temperature of -32.4  $^{\circ}$ C/-26.3  $^{\circ}$ F on the 21st broke the previous record of -40.4  $^{\circ}$ C/-40.7 set in 2003.

The peak wind of 38 kts/44 mph on the 21st broke the previous record of 32 kts/37 mph set in 2009.

The maximum temperature of -32.8 °C/-27.0 °F on the 22nd broke the previous record of -33.7 °C/-28.7 set in 1969.
